Don Millard, Ph.D.

Dr. Don Millard is currently serving as the Deputy Division Director of the Engineering Education and Centers (EEC) Division, within the Engineering Directorate, at the National Science Foundation (NSF). At NSF, he has served in a number of roles, as an acting Division Director, a Deputy Division Director and a Program Director - who was involved with the Advanced Technology Education (ATE) program, the Math and Science Partnership (MSP) program, and as the lead of the Transforming Undergraduate Education in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (TUES) program. He was also a founder of both the EHR Core Research (ECR) and the Innovation Corps (I-Corps) programs. Prior to joining NSF, Dr. Millard spent 27 years at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute where he served as a faculty member of the Electrical, Computer, and Systems Department and directed a number of research centers; including the Center for Integrated Electronics and the Academy of Electronic Media. Dr. Millard has been voted Professor of the Year on three occasions, selected as RHA Professor of the Month, and was chosen as the Eta Kappa Nu Outstanding Professor."
